The distinguished pianist Aris Graikousis, from Heraklion, Crete, having performed numerous times in solo recitals, chamber music concerts, and music-theatrical performances in Heraklion, will present a piano recital as part of "the Crete Festival". Aris Graikousis will perform works by L.V. Beethoven, F. Mendelssohn, Fr. Chopin, and A. Khachaturian. Specifically, the pieces that the pianist will present are as follows:

The "Adagio of Spartacus & Phrygia" from Khachaturian's ballet, as well as the Toccata by the same composer, Beethoven's Sonata op. 53 No. 21 "Waldstein," one of the composer's most famous and demanding sonatas, with both technical virtuosity and lyrical elements.

In the second part, the program will include Mendelssohn's "Variations sérieuses" op. 54, perhaps his most significant piano work, the "Nocturne" op. Posthume in C sharp minor, and Chopin's "Polonaises" op. 40 No. 1 "Military" and op. 53 "Heroic".

"The Blue7 ensemble"

The Blue7 ensemble is a new music group that is original and innovative due to its composition. It consists of three woodwind instruments, three brass instruments, and a drum set. Based in Heraklion, its goal is to present a different sound and perspective in the music scene through its performances. Its repertoire includes works by Astor Piazzolla, Chick Corea, David Brubeck, George Gershwin, and many other notable composers from the jazz genre. The unique ensemble features Maria Alexaki on flute, Eva Lasithiotaki on saxophone, Sofia Papoutsaki on clarinet, Kostas Palios on euphonium, Charalampos Palios on tuba, Manolis Sfakianakis on trombone, and Vangelis Tsagarakis on drums. Accompanying them is the acclaimed vocalist Vasilis Lekkas, performing well-known hits by Manos Hadjidakis, Mikis Theodorakis, Giannis Spanos, Giorgos Trantalidis, and others. Haris Sarris joins them on the piano. The arrangements of the pieces are done by Spyros Mavropoulos, Charalampos Palios, and Spyros Prosoparis.

"Tetrachord Piano Ensemble - Concert for 2 Pianos, 8 Hands"

Starting time: 21:00

Four pianists on two pianos have the ability to produce mesmerizing orchestral sounds. The Sonata by Smetana is one of the few original romantic works for this combination. New Zealander Paul Sarsich and Polish Marek Pasieczny experiment with complex rhythmic patterns, utilizing all the keys of the piano, as well as the tonal colors created by the performers inside the instrument. Russian Rosenblatt and American Wilberg draw inspiration from famous Japanese melodies ("Red Dragonfly," "Song of the Seashore," and "Sakura") and from the opera Carmen respectively, creating compositions-fantasies filled with humor, theatricality, virtuosity, and contrasts. Also, Rachmaninoff's 1st Suite, dedicated to Tchaikovsky, is a work of imagination inspired by four Russian poems.

The visionary American composer, George Kramb, "describes" the evolution of our planet during prehistoric eras through the voice of the whale, urging the performers of his work to wear masks and be bathed in blue light. Darius Milhaud draws inspiration from African mythology on the creation of the world, reminding us simultaneously that jazz, as part of black music, created a new musical world in the 20th century. However the creation of music also generates worlds!

Thus, Schumann's Piano Quintet, one of the most enchanting chamber music works of Romanticism, gave birth to a remarkable musical genre that has been embraced by great composers up to the present day.

The Chamber Music Festival Chania enters its second decade of existence in the artistic events of Crete. Since its inaugural concert in 2012 at the grand hall of the Minoa Palace Resort in Chania, it has been held uninterruptedly, attracting hundreds of listeners each year. With 34 unique concerts and hosting at least 5,000 Greek and foreign music lovers, it has become an internationally recognized musical event.

For the second year in a row, the collaboration between the Chamber Music Festival Chania and the Crete Festival continues.
